

BASIC INFORMATION & ARTIST GUIDELINES

HOW TO APPLY: Schedule an appointment to jury by contacting our website www.sixdaysart.com. Bring your **completed application, \$10.00 non-refundable application fee, and samples of your art** (also, portfolio if applicable) to jury. Plan on doing a casual presentation followed by a brief question and answer period. You will receive a call within 24 hours to let you know if you've been accepted.

GUIDELINES: All work presented in the store must be entirely the work of the artist. Displays used to showcase your work must be approved by the board. Members will decide by a majority vote whether or not the art presented falls within the guidelines we have drafted below.

- **2 D Artists:** *All 2D art must be matted, mounted, or framed. Canvas must be museum mounted (no staples on edges and not left white). All framed art must be wire hung. Fiber art does not need to be wire mounted, but does need to be clean in presentation with a viable means of hanging. All prints and note cards must be in jackets. Contact information about the artist must be included on the back of your reproduced work. We encourage you to place Six Days information here too. We will provide title cards for you to fill in title and price. These will be uniform throughout the store.*
- **Jewelry Artists:** *All jewelry must be designed and assembled by the artist/member. Purchased chains and cords for pendants are acceptable.*
- **Clothing:** *All clothing must be created entirely by the artist. Recycled clothing must be significantly altered to the artist's unique style. Original art may be printed, drawn, sewn, or stenciled in any manner onto manufactured clothing such as tee shirts, sweatshirts etc.*

EXPOSURE: As a member you will be included on our website with a link to your own website. We encourage our artists to link back to the Six Days website. A Yahoo e-mail address will be provided for you if you don't have one. Every artist is entitled to do a *Featured Artist* show.

General Rules & Regulations:

1. Artists/Members are expected to maintain professionalism individually, and as a group.
2. Be courteous and respectful to other members and our store. Do not leave personal items in the store.
3. You may not disturb or rearrange another artist's display or the front windows without permission.
4. For security reasons, no entering the store after 10:00pm without notifying our upstairs tenant. The tenant will call the store if someone is heard entering. If you do not answer the phone, the police will be called.
5. Keep music and noise to a respectable level that won't disturb neighbors and customers.
6. No alcoholic beverages while on shift, or when hanging out in the store. No open/obvious alcoholic beverages (i.e. beer bottles, liquor bottles) during events/parties. All alcohol must be in a cup or concealed container, and must not leave the store according to OLCC rules.
7. When on register shift, especially during an event or party, you cannot leave the register area without leaving another member in charge or locking up the store.
8. No signs are to be taped to the front windows or doors. We do not put flyers for outside events anywhere in the store, with the exception of member involvement. Direct people with flyers to our event board on the alley side of the building.
9. Absolutely NO borrowing money from the till. See *Membership Agreement* for rules regarding a short till.
10. Supervised & well-behaved pets are allowed in the store (members & customers).
11. Any member can be voted out by a majority vote by all members, at any time.
